The upper tribunal refuses permission to appeal the first tier tribunal decision of 6 August 2017.

Note

[1] In terms of section 22 of the 2011 Act an appeal to the upper tribunal may only be made on a point of law. Having considered the application and the reasons advanced I am not able to detect any arguable point of law. The original application for leave to appeal made to the first tier tribunal sought to challenge the ruling that the tribunal could not look behind the earlier decisions of the Sheriff Court. I can detect no error of law in that ruling. [2] The grounds of appeal now advanced are substantially different. Essentially the applicant appears to seek a review of the factual position something which it is not competent for the upper tribunal to undertake.
