The sheriff, having considered the information presented at the inquiry, determines in terms of section 26(2)(a) of the Act that Dawn Marshall died at 0145 hours on 26 August 2015 at Forth Valley Royal Hospital, Stirling Road, Larbert;

In terms of section 26 (2) (c) of the Act the cause of death was complications of acute bowel ischaemia due to mesenteric venous thrombosis in a woman with decompensated alcohol-related liver disease (previous surgical repair of bowel herniation);

In terms of section 26(2)(e) of the Act there are no precautions which could reasonably have been taken that might realistically have resulted in her death being avoided;

In terms of section 26(2)(f) of the Act there are no defects in any system of working which contributed to her death;

In terms of section 26(2)(g) of the Act there are no other facts relevant to the circumstances of her death;

In terms of section 26(1)(b) of the Act there are no recommendations to make;

In terms of section 27(5) of the Act directs that the Note to this determination is to be withheld from publication under section 27(1)(a) of the Act.
