- 2. The inquiry is a discretionary inquiry under section 4 of the Inquiries into Fatal Accidents and Sudden Deaths etc. (Scotland) Act 2016. The Lord Advocate having considered that the death occurred in circumstances giving rise to serious public concern and that it is in the public interest for a public inquiry to be held into the circumstances of the death. The said Harris James Macdonell, died on 19th August 2020, his death was caused by electrocution having climbed an electricity pole. This inquiry is necessary to examine the care and treatment provided to Harris James Macdonell and to examine whether steps might have been taken to avoid the death.
- 3. A preliminary hearing has been fixed for Wednesday 7 August 2024 at 2.00pm within Sheriff Court House, Ettrick Terrace, Selkirk TD74LE.
