**SCOTTISH PARLIAMENTARY QUESTION S6W-16645  
ELECTRIC VEHICLES IN SCOTTISH COURTS**

The Cabinet Secretary in his response to the above PQ indicated that it related to operational matters within the responsibility of the Scottish Courts and Tribunals Service corporate body. I am now writing in response to the matter raised.

**S6W-16645** asks: the Scottish Government how many electric vehicles the Scottish Courts and Tribunals Service (SCTS) has access to, and how many electric vehicle chargers are available for use by SCTS staff on or within SCTS premises.

The SCTS has 12 Electric Vehicles and 63 charging base units installed each able to charge 2 cars. The charging base units are available to staff, judiciary and contracted suppliers.
